THE MARKET PLACE FOR CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT INDUSTRY

Infrastructure sector is a key driver for the Indian economy. The sector is highly responsible for propelling India's overall development and enjoys intense focus from Government for initiating policies that would ensure time-bound creation of world class infrastructure in the country. Infrastructure sector includes power, bridges, dams, roads and urban infrastructure development.

The Indian economy is currently around Rs 190 lakh crore (GDP at current market prices, 2018-19) which comes out to be \$2.8 trillion, converting it in dollar terms taking average exchange rate of the financial year.

Depiction of the Indian economy, projecting the country's gross domestic product (GDP) would grow at 7% in 2019-20, against a five-year low of 6.8 per cent the preceding year. This low in GDP was with political stability facilitating a pick-up in demand and investments. India would need to grow at 8 per cent annually to become a \$5-trillion economy by FY25.

INDIA'S SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT REQUIRES INVESTMENT WORTH OF RS 50 TRILLION (US\$ 777.73 BILLION) IN INFRASTRUCTURE BY 2022

- Allocation of INR 4.56 lakh crore (US\$ 63.20 billion) will give massive push to the infrastructure sector
- INR 2.05 lakh crore (US\$ 31.81 billion) will be invested for initiatives like 'Housing for All' and 'Smart Cities Mission'.
- INR 83,015.97 crore (US\$ 11.51 billion) was allocated for National Highways Authority of India (NHAI).
- INR 19,000 crore (US\$ 2.63 billion) is allocated to Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for development of roads in rural and backward areas of the country.
- INR 66.77 billion (US\$ 9.25 billion) is allotted to the Indian Railways, Out of this allocation, Rs 64.587 Billion (US\$ 8.95 billion) is for capital expenditure.
- 2,000 Kms of coastal connectivity roads have been identified for construction and development.
- INR 830.15 Billion (US\$ 11.51 Billion) is allotted for road transport and highway.
- NH Roads will see awarding sanction of approximately 60,000 Kms in the next 5 years.
- The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has invested around US\$ 50 billion in last 3 years.
- An estimated US\$ 60 billion outlay has been planned for highways for the coming 5 years with an attempt to double the network of National Highways.
- Metro rail projects worth over Rs 500 billion (\$7.7 billion) are underway in India and this pile will probably grow.

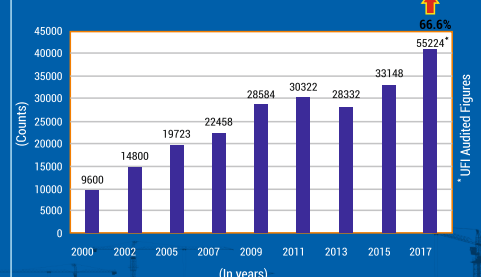
